



WELL CHILD EXAM SCHEDULE

Because childhood and adolescence are dynamic periods of growth and development, pediatricians are trained to recognize the unique needs of each child to help each achieve his/her maximum potential. Among the many services provided by pediatricians, immunizations, and screening for illnesses may be the most familiar.

Our practice follows the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) recommendations which states that newborns should be seen within 24 to 72 hours after being discharged from the hospital. Your child will also be seen six times or more within the first year of life and continue with well child exams every year through the age of 18. Additional screening tests and immunizations recommended by the AAP are listed below. Your child deserves the best care modern medicine has to offer—that's why you chose us.

3 Years	Exam, Tuberculosis Questionnaire, Urinalysis, Vision Screening, P- Hearing Screening
4 Years	Exam, MMR #2, Varivax #2, Urinalysis, Hearing Screening, Vision Screening, Tuberculosis Questionnaire
5 Years (Kindergarten)*	Exam, DTAP #5, IPV #4, Tuberculosis Questionnaire, Vision Screening, Urinalysis, Hearing Screening
6 Years	Exam, Vision Screening, Urinalysis, Hearing Screening
7 Years	Exam, Vision Screening, Urinalysis, Hearing Screening

9 Years	Exam, Gardasil (Series of 3 Shots) Girls & Boys, Vision Screening, Urinalysis, Hearing Screening

16 Years (11 th Grade)*	Exam, Tuberculosis Questionnaire, Vision Screening, Urinalysis, Hearing Screening
